

Prague is the capital of the Czech Republic. Nowadays it covers a total area of 496 square kilometers with 1,187,000 inhabitants. Almost three million tourists come to visit Prague every year. The historical centre with a unique panorama of the Prague Castle is an urban conservation area of UNESCO.

Competition venue:

The competition and workout will be held at the Strahov Stadium, which is approved by international standards for competitions. The athletic stadium is by foot from the hotel.

Accommodation:

Entry fee:

20% of the entry fee should be paid together with the 1st entry and the remaining amount together with the final entry.

The price per person for the whole stay covers:

- accommodation /sharing in double rooms and in some cases triple rooms or single rooms)
- meals (starts with dinner arrival day to breakfast departure day)
- local transports (airport hotel and back)
- cultural program
- INAS capitation fee

Sports rules and regulation:

According to the rules of IAAF (International Amateur Athletics Federation) and INAS.

Athlete Eligibility:


All athletes entering the event must appear on the INAS Classification Master List no later than the final entry deadline. Applications for new athletes must be submitted to INAS as soon as possible. Athletes who do not meet the qualifying criteria or do not appear on the INAS Classification Master List are not eligible for this event. There is no "guest" entry here.

Sports classification:

At this time, it is not proposed to include a sports classification service at this event. However, if this becomes necessary however, then this may incur an additional fee for those athletes seeking classification.

Accreditation:

Accreditation cards will be issued to each athlete only after he/she has personally shown his/her valid passport to the Event Eligibility Officer. Accreditation will also be provided to staff and other officials at registration, with passport and two passport photos.

Team Competition Format

According to the INAS guidelines and in order to encourage nations to participate, the World Championships will have individual and team competition per sex (male and female). In the Team Competition each competing nation only is classified one (1) athlete per event (the best classified in the individual competition). Only nations with a minimum of 3 participants athletes per sex are eligible to participate in the Team Competition of this sex (male or female).

The classification system for Team Competition is:

- n points for 1st classified,
- n-1 points for 2nd classified,
- n-2 points for 3rd classified, and so on for other places.

(n) is the number of nations eligible for participation in the Team Competition per sex.
