DID YOU KNOW?

Tereza started athletics at the age of seven and took up the hammer throw (the best discipline, of course) at 14, a year after breaking her leg in the hurdles. Her mum joked that using crutches would make her so strong she'd become a thrower. After stepping away from athletics following the 2021 season, she returned in 2023, surpassed 60 metres for the first time, and began believing she could qualify for a major championship. She has been coached by Jiří Kreuter, Stanislav Pluhař, Petr Sklenář, and, since 2026 season, Vladimír Maška. She trained with Mr Pluhař alongside her sister Klárka, a shot putter who was tragically killed in the 2023 shooting at the Faculty of Arts. Tereza works as a gym trainer and hopes to specialise in strength training for older adults. In her free time, she enjoys baking, nature, and spending time with her boyfriend (also hammer thrower), family, and sisters.

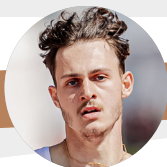

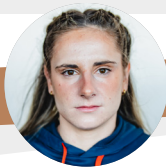
